

# MINNESOTA NOMINATING PETITION FOR PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS AND ALTERNATE ELECTORS

We, the undersigned eligible voters, nominate by petition the following 10 presidential electors and alternates representing the \_\_\_\_\_ (political party or principle, no more than 3 words) to be represented on the ballot by \_\_\_\_\_ (Name of presidential candidate and state of residence) and \_\_\_\_\_ (Name of vice-presidential candidate and state of residence) as candidates for the offices of President and Vice-President of the United States, respectively, to be voted on at the election to be held on November 5, 2024.

Each petition must have a short title describing the purpose of the petition. M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(C).

The language on the petition must be printed in at least 10-point type. M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(B).

"...One petition may be filed to nominate a slate of presidential electors equal in number to the number of electors to which the state is entitled and an alternate for each elector nominee" M.S. 204B.07, subd. 2

The signer's oath and the signature lines must be on the same side of the paper. M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(A)

"Each petition page must have a signer's oath in no smaller than 12-point bold type..." M.R. 8205.1010, subp.2(F)

"Each petition page must have a statement summarizing the purpose of the petition." M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(D)

"...On petitions nominating presidential electors, or alternates, the names of the candidates for president and vice president shall be added to the political party or political principal stated on the petition..." M.S. 204B.07, subd. 2

"Each petition page must include the following statement "All information on this petition is subject to public inspection." M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(I)

Each petition page must include the following statement immediately above the signature lines: "All information must be filled in by person(s) signing the petition unless disability prevents the person(s) from doing so." M.R. 8205.1010, subp 2(G).

The petition cannot be prepared on paper larger than 8 1/2 inches wide by 14 inches long. M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(A)

"A nominating petition may consist of one or more separate pages each of which state:  
 (a) the office sought  
 (b) the candidate's name and residence address, including street and number if any; and  
 (c) the candidate's political party or political principal expressed in not more than three words..."  
 M.S. 204B.07, subd. 1.

After the information about the office sought, presidential candidates name, vice presidential candidate's political party name, and the names of presidential electors being nominated, and before the space for signing each separate page that is part of the petition shall include an oath in the following form: "I solemnly swear (or affirm) that I know the contents and purpose of this petition, that I do not intend to vote at the primary election for the office for which this nominating petition is made, and that I signed this petition of my own free will." M.S. 204B.07, subd. 4.

**DO NOT USE THIS AS YOUR ACTUAL PETITION. This is only an example to provide guidance in preparing your petition. This petition is not to be used by Major Political Party candidates.**

"Each petition page must have no more than ten signature lines. The signature lines must be consecutively numbered. Each signature line must have space for the date of signature; a signature; and each signatory's year of birth; printed first, middle, and last name, and residence address, municipality, and county." M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(H)
